In our rapidly changing world, various environmental hazards cause considerable damages and loss of life, and often these are related to the geomorphological setting of an area (e.g. mass movements, flash floods), or their consequences change the rate of geomorphological processes and forms. Following the traditions, the conference, will contain of plenary lectures, thematic sessions and field trips. The exact title of the thematic sessions will be determined just after the submission of abstracts.
